I can hardly believe we are approaching the end of this first half term of 2021. It has flown by!



There are two ways to be able to book appointments with your child's mentor:

1) Via the Weduc app. If you already have this app then you only need to click on the 'Access Parents' Evening Bookings' tab, this will automatically take you through to the website, with no further need to login.

The guide also contains important information on how you attend the appointments over video call.

Please note:

- This will then <u>close on Tuesday 23rd February</u> at 12pm.
- Appointments will be strictly 5 minutes long in order to enable staff to meet with all of the parents/students in their mentor group, so please be aware that after this time period has elapsed the session will automatically time out.
- The Parents' guide also contains important information on how you attend the appointments over video call.
- Blended Learning Engagement Reports will be uploaded to Weduc prior to the mentor evening.
